More than 30 million days are lost each year due to work-related illness and injuries suffered in UK workplaces.

This not only indicates the scale of suffering experienced by workers, it also demonstrates the challenge for businesses.

The ISO 45001 Occupational Health and Safety Management System (OHSMS) is the single most effective means of exercising managerial control over not just the wellbeing of your workers, but everyone affected by your organisation's activities. It provides a management framework to help you comply with legislation and improve risk management, resulting in more effective practices and reduced ill health and injuries.

The system is extremely effective at helping organisations meet their legal obligations. Now that senior managers are held personally responsible and since new sentencing guidelines were introduced in 2016, those organisations who take risk management seriously are turning to ISO 45001 as the solution.

It's often a mandatory requirement when tendering for new business, especially when bidding for work with larger organisations or the public sector.
